2. Guidelines on Authorship

Key Principles for Determination of Authorship (Referenced from

International Committee of Medical Journal Editors http://www.icmje.org/urm_main.html)

- Authorship credit should be based on:
 - 1. Substantial contributions to conception and design, acquisition of data or analysis and interpretation of data
 - 2. Drafting the article or revising it critically for important intellectual content
 - 3. Final approval of the version to be published.

Authors should meet conditions 1-3.

- Acquisition of funding, collection of data, or general supervision of the research group alone does not constitute authorship.
- Each author should have participated sufficiently in the work to take public responsibility for appropriate portions of the content.

2. Guidelines on Authorship Plan

- All contributors who do not meet the criteria for authorship should be listed in acknowledgements section.
- Groups of persons who have contributed materially to the paper but whose contributions do not justify authorship may be listed under such headings as "clinical investigators" or "participating investigators" and their function or contributions should be described (e.g. served as scientific advisors, collected data etc)
 Because readers may infer endorsements of those listed in acknowledgements, contributors must give written permission to be acknowledged.
