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
Introduction

- It has been shown that there are wide variations in survival outcomes between communities, and it has been suggested that these differences are mainly due to differences in how pre-hospital emergency care is delivered.
- In the last 3 years, the PAROS network has grown the number of participating countries from seven to thirteen.
- we aimed to compare system factors and OHCA outcomes between a more diversified portfolio of Asian countries.
