

Stats

- 293 Incidents
- 138 responses
- 9 arrival before fire
- 5 patients shocked
- 4 probable saves
- Unintended consequences (helping non-cardiac patients)

What's most effective?

Seattle/King County Medical Leadership

– Telecommunicator CPR

- A Telecommunicator/Dispatcher can recognize SCA quickly
 - 60 seconds or less
 - Provide hands only CPR instructions
 - Rapid Dispatch EMS/ Police AED response

AHA Program Recommendations

- Commitment to TCPR by Com centers and directors
- Train and provide continuing education for all telecommunicators.
- Conduct QI on ALL confirmed cardiac arrest and resuscitation is attempted
- Communication between EMS agencies and Com centers to measure and improve

AHA Program Recommendations

 Designated Medical Director to issue protocols and coordinate between Com centers and EMS agencies.

• Recognition of outstanding performance
