Southern Malaysia

- Data collection using Research Assistant was temporarily stopped due to funding issues for many sites.
- One of the sites is still sending data into the system.
- Major site is undergoing some restructuring of administration process and will begin contribution of data by August.
- Prehospital care records are in many sites not centralized therefore there maybe problems in tracing datas.

Northern Malaysia

- Recruited site but delay in starting data collection – to start in November (Alor Setar)
- Will include one more site in mainland Penang by early next year

East Malaysia

- Sarawak state has 2 sites (Kuching & Miri) and data collection on going
- Recent training on high performance CPR done with northern region (Penang) instructors to Sibiu.

PAROS GRA – Implementation plan/progress

Step	Implementation
Establish a cardiac arrest registry	Method of gathering data is in testing phase. Compilation of information into a registry format is in discussion phase with MOH.
Begin Telephone-CPR with ongoing training and QI	T-CPR is already implemented using the EMD protocol. February 2017, we got all MECC MD to agree to perform QI for T-CPR
Begin high-performance EMS CPR with ongoing training and QI	Since 2016, we have been doing a done day course on HP-EMS CPR open to all PHCS responders. Up to date about 200 responders/year have been trained. QI measurements will be feasible by 4 th quarter of the year.
Begin rapid dispatch	Implemented and monitored centrally. Monitoring by indirect method of summation of the response time.

Step	Implementation
Begin an AED program for first responders, including police officers, guards, and other security personnel	<p>WE have so far succeeded in getting corporate sector to start their AED programme and training. The first is the MRT train service in Kuala Lumpur.</p> <p>Penang has Penang Heart Save program, 10 public AEDs government funded with training to various ERTs include security guards, police personnel.</p> <p>Implemented in 8 schools, in process of implementing at state level via Penang Science Cluster for schools</p> <p>In process of procuring & implementing for Penang State Fire Dept – 10 stations EMRS teams for next year.</p> <p>Corporate sector – engaging with Funicular Railway.</p>

Step	Implementation
Use smart technologies to extend CPR and public access defibrillation programs to notify volunteer bystanders who can respond to nearby arrest to provide early CPR and defibrillation	Penang is venturing in the system. Have begun registration process for Good SamApp. Will implement at MECC by year end.
Make CPR and AED training mandatory in schools and the community	Early implementation phase. Penang having discussions for collaboration between state level health and education ministries – had trained education ministry staff (50 pax) and want to train 1-2 teachers of all state owned schools (TOT) next year before roll out to schools. Current on going training to individual schools Training to police started 11/10/17 -90 personnel Perak has been doing ongoing CPR training to schools and community – 676 persons trained over 2017 Pahang done community CPR training -297 persons trained
