1. Update from Each PAROS Country – Using ePAROS

Singapore

- 826 entries entered (as of 21 Nov 2011)

Thailand

- Rajavithi Hospital: 2 cases entered (as of 21 Nov 2011)
- Prince of Songkla University: 1 case entered (as of 21 Nov 2011)

Malaysia

- IRB approval status
 - 310 cases entered (as of 21 Nov 2011)
- Main issues with entering:
 - Difficulty getting hospital data from ED
 - Affects mostly cases that are conveyed to hospital

Dubai

- Received translated IRB approval letter
- 176 cases entered (as of 21 Nov 2011)

4. Updates in ePAROS System

Summary of updates

No	Item	Updates
1	Race	<p>Different options for race can now be added into the system for each country by PAROS administrator.</p> <p>Account users have to inform PAROS administrator of the different options if they wish to add it into the system.</p>
2	Validation rule – Dispatch Timings	System is able to recognize cases that were brought in past midnight and will not flag this as an error.
3	Exported data	Data exported into excel is organized in the same sequence as PAROS CRF for consistency and easier comparison.
4	Dashboard	Account users can now view their respective data collection progress on their dashboard by adding ‘Agency Productivity – Volume by month’ from the dashboard builder dropdown list.

6.0 Budget

- Please provide a detailed budget including a description and justification for each category of expense.
- The budget should be in proportion with the amount of work/basic salary.

Allowable costs

- Salary support
 - Principal investigator - cannot be higher than € 20.000 per year
 - Secondary investigators - cannot be higher than € 5.000 per Year
 - Technical support (research fellows, research assistants, clinical coordinators, research nurses, statisticians)
- Overhead
 - Office supplies – incl. computer hard- and software
 - Secretarial support
 - Administrative support
- Statistical support
- Travel
- Research supplies and equipment – we do not consider basic ambulance equipment as fundable research items

Notes

- In general, the overhead and travel expenses should not be over 30 % of the total budget.
- Once the agreement has been signed, up to an agreed upon percentage of the budget will be paid.
- In presenting the budget the investigator must describe the connection between the budget and the research project milestones.
- In general the first payment will usually not exceed 50% of the total budget.
- The payments must be made through the supporting institution or supporting legal entity
