OHCA Registries Meeting: Discussions about setting up Out-Of-Hospital Cardiac Arrest (OHCA) registries

29-30 Oct 2018

Academia, Singapore General Hospital, Singapore

For the very first time, international registries gathered together at Academia in Singapore General Hospital (SGH) from 29 to 30 October 2018 to share their experiences and challenges faced when setting up out-of-hospital cardiac arrest (OHCA) registries in their region or country.

Hosted by SCRI's Pan-Asian Resuscitation Outcomes Study (PAROS) Clinical Research Network, the OHCA Registries Meeting saw attendees such as representatives from Cardiac Arrest Registry to Enhance Survival (CARES), European Registry of Cardiac Arrest (EuReCa) and Australian Resuscitation Outcomes Consortium (Aus-ROC). Members from PAROS were also present at the meeting.

With a focus on operational topics specific to managing country-level registries, participants agreed to meet on an annual basis. The next meeting is set to take place in Australia by Aus-ROC team.
